RECEPTION, YEAR 1 and YEAR 2 VISIT TO VUE CINEMA - Friday10th November

Next week is Into Film week and the school has managed to get tickets to go and watch 'Puss in Boots – The Last Witch' at Vue Cinema on Botchergate. The trip will be for all children in Reception, Y1 and Y2. Travel to the cinema will be by coach and the screening is from 10.00 - 11.50am with the children returning to school in time for lunch.
