Further Information for the post of Midday Supervisor

The Post

- The position is for a Midday Supervisor. The post is part-time, working 7.5 hours per week.
- The position is permanent
- The position is subject to the school receiving satisfactory references
- Daily hours will be 11.45 13.15.
- The role involves supervising the children whilst having lunch from approximately 12.00 12.30 and then supervising them outside from approximately 12.30 13.00. The times before and after this are used for setting up and clearing away the dinner tables.
- Other midday supervision at the school is done by teaching assistants at the school. The amount of indoor/outdoor supervision is shared amongst four people.
- Relevant training will be given to the successful candidate, if required.
- As this post involves work with and/or access to children, please note that the appointment will be subject to registration with the Independent Safeguarding Authority and an enhanced DBS check.
- An application form is available on our website. Forms are also available to download from the Cumberland Council website.
- Applications for the post should be e-mailed to head@cummersdale.cumbria.sch.uk or sent to the school by Thursday 16th October. Interviews are likely to take place w/b 20th October.
- It is anticipated that the successful candidate will commence the post as soon as possible after the October Half term. However, allowances may be made for the right candidate.

The School

- Cummersdale School is a small village primary school on the urban fringes of Carlisle. Founded in 1884, it originally provided education for the children of Cummersdale. Today, many of our children come from outside Cummersdale, mainly from the Denton Holme, Morton and Dalston areas of Carlisle.
- There are currently 99 children in the school. There are 4 classes: Reception, Y1/Y2, Y3/4 and Y5/6.
- There are fourteen members of staff
- The children enjoy school; they are keen to learn and the behaviour of the children is good.
- The school has attractive traditional buildings and spacious grounds.
- The school was judged to be 'good' by Ofsted in May 2022.
- Sporting activities and achievements are a key feature of the school. Staff provide a wide range of extra curricular activities which include gym, football, running and hockey as well as geocaching, science and lego.
